

Dr. Martin Mandew is the Principal of the Qwaqwa Campus of the University of the Free State. Prior to that he was the Campus Director of the Midlands Campus of the Durban University of Technology, Pietermaritzburg. He holds a Bachelor of Sacred Theology (Urbaniana Pontifical University, Rome), Master of Theology (University of Natal), University Diploma in Management Development (University of Durban-Westville), and a PhD (University of Natal).
